- Final report documenting the project. It needs to contain significant technical content. The aim of this content is to bring a group continuing the project next year up to speed. They should not have to duplicate any of your efforts. The audience is that follow on group of engineering students. Also, appropriate material could be project management information, what went right/wrong, what you'd suggest the next group do different, etc.
- Oral "PowerPoint" presentation of project. The audience is other senior project students and other interested engineers.
- Web page. A small web page explaining the project. The best will be kept and linked to our departmental page. The purpose is to explain the project and create good PR for senior projects. The audience is high school students and their parents, as well as industrial partners.
- Participation in the Senior Project Symposium in the CU towards the end of the term.
- Results of the project, dependent on individual project.
