

STATEMENT OF STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE OIT ADMISSIONS PROCESS

STUDENTS RIGHTS

- Before you apply, you have the right to receive factual and comprehensive information from Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT) about practices and policies related to admission, costs, financial aid and housing.
- After you apply, you have the right to know your status in the admission process.
- You have the right to wait until May 1 to respond to an offer of admission and/or financial aid for the subsequent fall quarter.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- It is your responsibility to research and understand the policies of OIT and other colleges regarding policies and practices related to application fees, admissions, financial aid, transfer of credit and housing.
- You must provide complete and truthful answers to all questions on the Application for Admissions and submit in a timely fashion all materials necessary to complete your admission file.
- If you are offered admission to OIT, you must notify OIT of your intent to enroll or your decision to pursue an alternative option. For fall enrollment, this notification should occur by May 1.
