Guiding Principles

- To ensure that the rights of all individuals are protected while attending the camp.
- To establish the safest & best possible learning environment for all camp participants.
- To ensure that breaches of the Code of Conduct are treated in a fair and consistent manner and within the expectations of all involved.

Rights	Responsibilities & Expectations
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All individuals have a right that they and their property are to be valued and treated with respect. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All campers have the responsibility to treat one another, staff and property with respect.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All individuals have the right to a safe, secure and cooperative working environment. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All campers have the responsibility to act and behave in a way which does not endanger, intimidate or interfere with the participation of others.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Staff has the right to perform their duties in an atmosphere of order and cooperation. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Campers have the responsibility to comply with instructions given by any member of staff.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Pre-College Programs has the right to expect support from all campers, parents, and staff in implementing this Code of Conduct. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All campers have the responsibility to behave according to this code and accept the consequences if it is violated.

Specific Rules at the Camp

Oregon Institute of Technology and Youth Programs is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please leave valuables at home.

The following forms of behavior are considered a violation of this document and are therefore **unacceptable** and could result in the immediate suspension of a camper(s):

- Cigarettes (or any tobacco products), alcohol, non-prescribed drugs, offensive weapons, and pornographic material must not be brought to the camp.
- Using language which is offensive, sexist or racist;
- Fighting, bullying or any other forms of aggressive behavior;
- Leaving camp boundaries without permission;
- Behaving in a manner which is potentially dangerous to self and others;
- Behaving in a manner which damages or vandalizes the property of others or the OIT campus.

Implementation Process

Youth Programs has developed levels of appropriate responses and sanctions. Any breach of the Code of Conduct will initiate a disciplinary action. The staff will decide the appropriate level of action.

Youth Programs reserves the right to suspend a camper's participation in camp activities, without refund of camp tuition if such disciplinary action is required. Before such a decision is fully made, the camper and parent/guardian will meet with Youth Programs staff and camp facilitator(s) to determine the best course of action.
