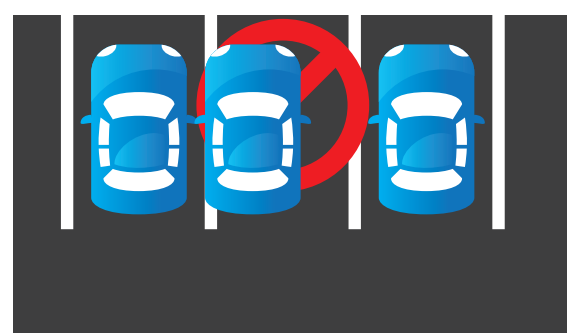
Top 10 Things to Remember About Parking on Campus

1. Head-in parking only.

Please do not back into a space. Motorcycle parking on campus is exempt from this requirement.



2. Park with your tires off the parking space divider lines.



3. Want to appeal a ticket? OIT citations are appealed by completing an on-line appeals form. This form is found on the OIT Campus Safety portion of the website under "Parking Services". Please follow the instructions provided on the on-line appeals form. Any questions, please call (541) 885-1551.

4. Residence hall parking permits are *only* valid for residence hall parking areas. Parking in other lots will result in ticketing.

5. Don't block Visitor parking. Visitor parking is defined as parking for persons not affiliated with the college. Visitor parking permits can be found at the Information booth in Lot D

6. Open Parking. Parking without parking permits is permissible in General Parking areas between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and weekends. Exceptions include reserved, service area, fire lanes, limited parking zones and ADA (Handicap) parking locations.

7. Parking on campus with an ADA (Handicap) permit without an accompanying current Oregon Tech parking permit is prohibited.

8. Adhesive parking permits must be applied to the outside of a vehicle's left back window or rear bumper. Please do not use other adhesive tape to attach permit to window surface.

9. Replace your adhesive parking permit for \$5. If you are driving a different vehicle or accidentally damage your adhesive parking permit, visit the Cashier's office to get a new one. To replace a hanging permit, expect to pay the full price of the permit.

10. All motor vehicle laws of the State of Oregon and ordinances of the City of Klamath Falls are applicable to the Oregon Tech.
