

OIT Library Services for Faculty

- ❖ **Information Literacy class sessions:** OIT librarians teach general, class-specific and assignment-specific sessions, depending on instructors' objectives. See <http://tiny.cc/qlybi> for library subject specialists. Sessions can be requested electronically at <http://tinyurl.com/6efjpn5> or in person. Please submit your requests at least two weeks in advance if possible.
- ❖ **Research assistance:** In-person research assistance from a librarian is available M-F, 9 am-3 pm at the Research Assistance desk. Research help via online chat is provided M-F, 8:30 am- 7 pm through the IM widget at the bottom right of the library's home page. E-mail research help is also available through libtech@oit.edu.
- ❖ **Student research consultations:** Students can meet one-on-one with a librarian subject specialist. Request an individual consultation by filling out the online form at <http://tinyurl.com/6ytkout> or completing paper request form at the Research Assistance desk. Students are usually contacted within 12 hours to confirm their appointment.
- ❖ **Library tours:** Schedule a tour for freshmen students, new faculty, local high school students, or a specific class at: <http://tinyurl.com/6efjpn5> .
- ❖ **Online tutorials and guides:** Online guides and tutorials can be accessed from the OIT library home page at: <http://www.oit.edu/libraries>.
- ❖ **Handouts:** Paper handouts are located on the shelf at the entrance to the library.
