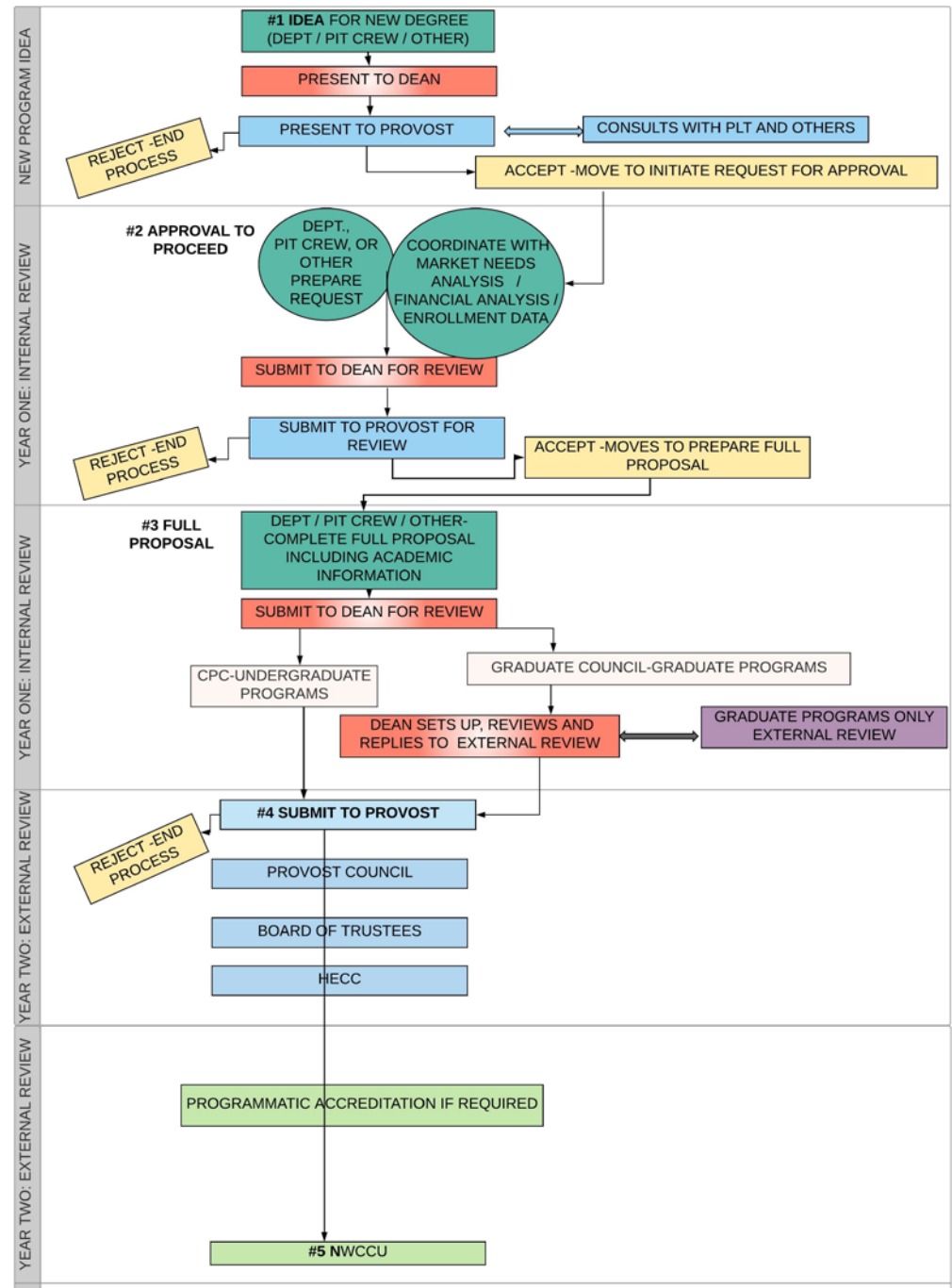

GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS FLOW CHART

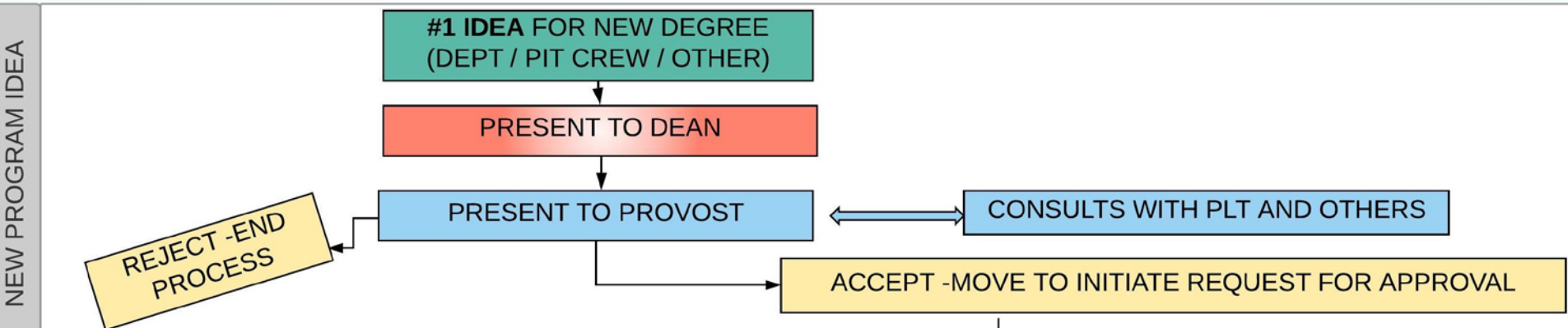
New Program Approval Process

Step 1. Idea incubator (<1 month)

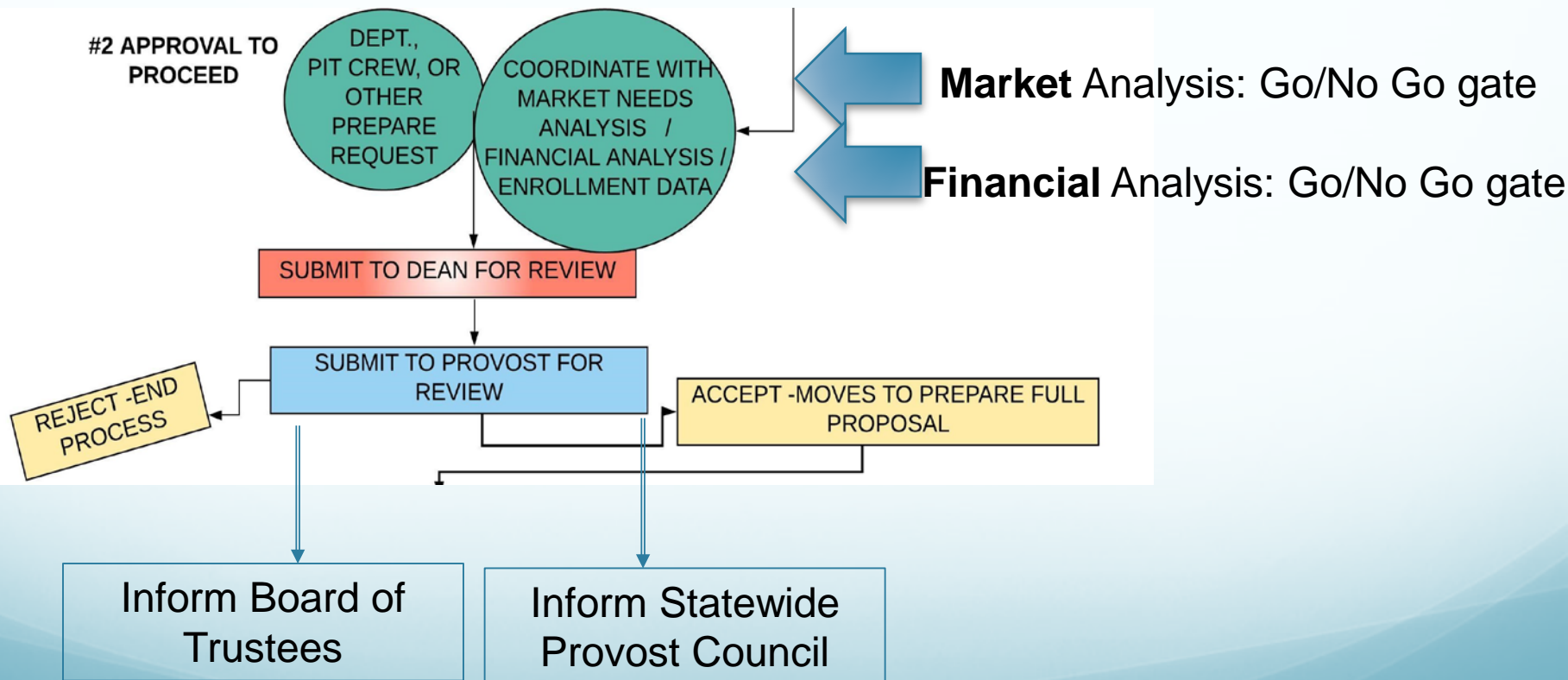
- I. **IDEA GENERATION BY FACULTY/DEPT/CHAIR(S)/EXECUTIVE STAFF**
- II. **FIRST VALIDATION OF POTENTIAL VIABILITY AT OREGON TECH- EXECUTIVE STAFF, ACAD COUNCIL**
- III. **GO/NO GO DECISION**

Step 2. Business case exploration (<3 months)

Approval to Proceed Process through Provost Office's



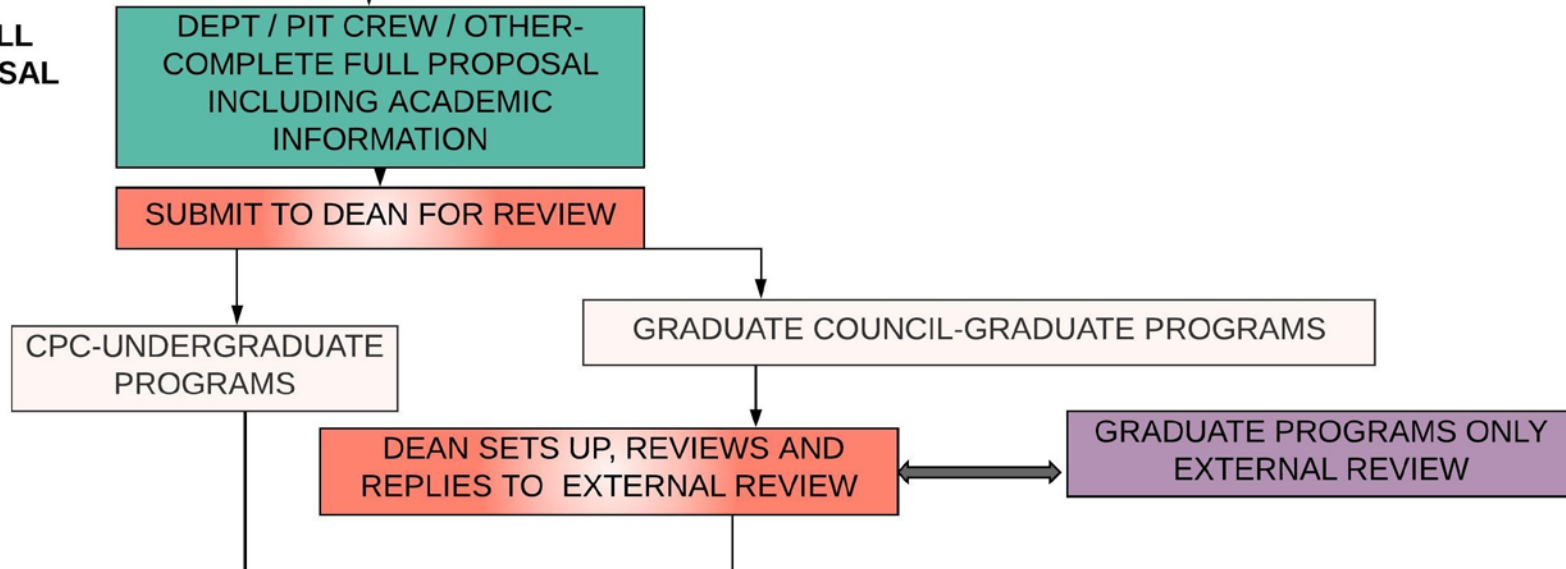
NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS

Step 3. Full Proposal Development & Submission (**<6 months**)

- b. **OR** Graduate Council
(will seek External Review)

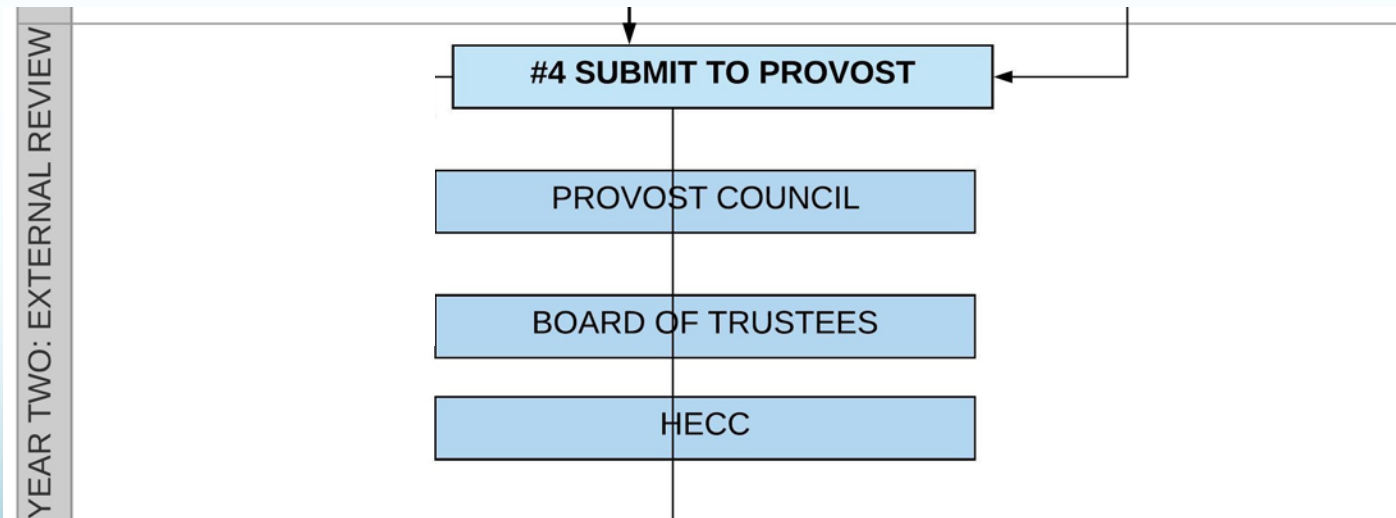


YEAR ONE: INTERNAL REVIEW

Step 5. Accrediting Body Reviews

NWCCU Liason Officer(LO) (LeAnn Maupin)

LO submits to NWCCU
