


GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS FLOW CHART






NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS Step 1. Idea incubator (<1 month)

NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS Step 2. Business case exploration (<3 months)



NEW PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS Step 3. Full Proposal Development & Submission (<6 months)


Full Proposal submission-
