For international students who are currently working as imaging technologists , there are two options to receive a Medical Imaging Technology degree from OIT:

1. If you have certification from a United States credentialing board (eg. ARRT, ARDMS, etc.), you may be eligible to complete our on line degree completion program See our Medical Imaging Technology web page <u>www.oit.edu/mit</u> for more information.

2. If you are not eligible for the online degree completion program, you may apply to one of the four year Medical Imaging Technology programs. You must have all prerequisites completed or in progress before you are eligible to apply to one of the programs.
