

FIGURE 2. HOW SATISFIED OR DISSATISFIED ARE YOU WITH THE FOLLOWING LEADERS?







FIGURE 3. HOW SATISFIED OR DISSATISFIED ARE YOU WITH OREGON TECH AS A PLACE OF WORK?
