




Headcount Comparison

Retention Actions

- College and departments each have newly developed retention plans
 - Student mentors, SI, faculty interactions, social events, advisory boards, reduce DFWI rates, proactive advising
- Embedded advisors hired for each college
- PC and SI expanded, implementation of math lab >27 SI's, >14 peer tutors
- Assistant Director for Academic Advising and Retention position filled
- Inspire software in implementation phase-
 - Identification of student populations with retention issues based on academic, demographic, and enrollment data.
 - Advisors get real-time student data with strategies for outreach, communication messages and intervention.
 - Personalized communication plans for specific student groups with multiple touch points
 - Centralized collaboration by aligning retention efforts with other departments
 - Alerts flag students to track and record follow up.
 - Registration/Scheduler: clear messaging to help students resolve registration errors quickly.
 - "Powerful Predictors" for retention outcomes allows focus on initiatives with the greatest potential impact, nudge campaigns to target student groups who are identified by the analytics program.
- Identify and text students with holds to provide assistance
- Weekly notifications to departments re unregistered students
- Consider and incorporate retention recommendations made in RNL report fall 2022.
