Sleep clinics may require you to provide a criminal background check, CPR or BLS card, proof of immunizations, and more as part of their onboarding practice. You may also be asked to perform certain medical tests, such as a urine drug screen or other tests. These requirements are set by the sleep labs and not by Oregon Tech.

I understand that securing a clinical site requires:

- finding a site that is willing to accept a student
- the completion of a legal affiliation agreement between the site and Oregon Tech
- successful student onboarding prior to the start of fall term

I understand the majority of my clinical hours will be on night/graveyard shift, approximately 18 hours/week over Fall and Winter, then a combination of night and day shifts in Spring term.

I understand that if I am dismissed from my clinical site I will be dropped from the Polysomnography program.

I understand that I must meet the sleep clinic's onboarding requirements in order to enroll in Oregon Tech's program.
