






Welcome to Oregon Tech's Dual Credit Program



Step 1: Applying for dual credit admission

- 1. Go to www.oit.edu/dual-credit
- 2. Click "Students & Families"
- 3. Select "CLICK HERE TO APPLY"





Step 2: Enter Biographical Information


- 1. Fill in all required fields (name, birthdate, and citizenship).
 - Note... Oregon Tech does not report individual students' citizenship status.
 - Please enter your legal first name. We will call you by the name you enter into the "Preferred First Name" field.
- 2. Reminder: Social Security Number is not required, but it is recommended for tax purposes.

Step 3: Enter Identity Information

 Sexual identity, gender identity, and racial/ethnic background questions will not be used in a discriminatory manner and are entirely optional.






Step 4: Enter Contact Information

- 1. We will send you an email with your student ID number and next steps to the email address you provide here. Be sure to check your junk/spam folder in case your email provider mistakes us for spam.
 - Double check to make sure you type your email address correctly.
- We recommend that you use a yahoo or gmail

account rather than your high school email as high schools often block messages from Oregon Tech.






Step 5: Parent/Guardian & Emergency Contact Information

Step 6: Enter High School Information

- 1. Enter your Secure School ID (SSID). Your teacher can help you if you don't know it.
- 2. Search for your high school. You can enter your city and state and choose your school if you can't find your high school.
- 3. Enter your graduation date.
- 4. Enter your GPA.
- 5. Select "courses at my high school" if you are a dual-credit student or "courses at Oregon Tech" if you are taking classes at Oregon Tech.
- An SSID is a unique, non-personally identifiable 10 digit number that all K-12 public school students are required to have. Your teacher can give you this number. Step 8: Application Certification & Submission

Application Certifications

Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), I understand that my educational records cannot be released without my written permission.

I, therefore, authorize the release of academic records and personally identifiable information between the high school district I attend and their post-secondary partners for purposes of determining eligibility to enroll in dual credit courses, to create an enrollment record with the post- secondary partner, and support my success in college level coursework. This may include, but is not limited to, application details, academic prerequisite information required to participate in specific courses, attendance records, test scores, progress reports from College instructors, course grades, tuition, and final exam grades.

When applicable, Oregon Tech will release tuition balance & payment information to payers. Oregon Tech will not release academic information to parents or guardians without a FERPA authorization form on file with the institution.
