WHAT IS THE OREGON TECH OWLS SCHOLARSHIP?

OWLS is a scholarship opportunity for high school students who are awarded at least 8 college credits of science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM) before they graduate. STEM college credits can be earned through programs like:

- Dual Credit
- Early College
- College Credit Now
- Willamette Promise or
- Classes Taken at the College

WHY SHOULD YOU APPLY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP?

Many students are earning college credit before they leave high school. Oregon Tech wants to reward your hard work and dedication to pursuing a college degree with a one-time scholarship!

Students can earn **\$1000** if their credits are from another institution other than Oregon Tech. Students will be awarded **\$1500** if their credits were earned through Oregon Tech's dual credit or High School Transition (HST) programs.

HOW DOES THE OWLS SCHOLARSHIP WORK?

Oregon Tech partners with high schools to provide early access to college-level courses.

Oregon Tech works with partner high schools to identify courses that can be offered for dual credit. It works in the following ways:

- Dual Credit Program (college credits earned in high school)
- Students elect to take college courses through Oregon Tech's High School Transition (HST) program.
- Partner high schools arrange for their students to take courses on Oregon Tech's campuses.
- STEM college credits may also be acquired at other accredited community colleges or universities that are transferable to Oregon Tech.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Any high school student who achieves 8 or more college credits in a science, technology, engineering or math course, with at least a grade of B or better, may apply for the Oregon Tech OWLS scholarship.
- The OWLS scholarship is open to all students; resident or out-of-state students

DEADLINES?

- All applications are due by March 1. You can still apply for the scholarship even if you have not yet completed all of the required dual-credit courses by the March 1 deadline.
- Official Transcripts must be turned in by July 31.

TO APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

2. Be Fully Admitted to Oregon Tech
3. Fill out the simple scholarship application at www.oit.edu/scholarships
4. Turn in all official college transcripts
