Before You Begin

- ❑ **Valid Email Address** - This should be an email you check frequently.
- ❑ **Social Security Number** (not required, but recommended for tax purposes)
- ❑ **Parent or Guardian email address**

2. Select **"APPLY NOW"**.

Step 2: Enter Biographical Information

1. Fill in all required fields (name and birth date).

- **Please enter your legal first name.**

Step 3: Enter Identity Information

1. Choose the appropriate response under “legal sex” and gender and sexuality drop down menus, as well as the racial/ethnic background questions.

- **PLEASE NOTE:** Only the “legal sex” question is required. Sexual identity, gender identity, and racial/ethnic background questions will not be used in a discriminatory manner and are entirely optional.

Step 4: Enter Contact Information

1. We will send you an email with your student ID number and next steps to the email address you provide here. Be sure to check your junk/spam folder in case your email provider mistakes us for spam.

- Double check to make sure you type your email address correctly.
- We recommend that you use a yahoo or gmail account rather than your high school email as high schools often block messages from Oregon Tech.

2. Enter your email address.

Step 6: Enter High School Information

1. Enter your **Secure School ID (SSID)**. Your teacher can help you if you don't know it. This field is required for Willamette Promise students. Optional for all others.
2. Search for your high school. You can enter your city and state and choose your school if you can't find your high school.
3. Enter **June 1** of your graduation year
4. Enter your GPA. Please note that this field is optional.
5. Select **"courses at my high school"** if you are a dual credit student or **"courses at Oregon Tech"** if you are taking classes at Oregon Tech.
6. Please indicate whether you qualify for a **tuition waiver**.

Application Certifications

Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), I understand that my educational records cannot be released without my written permission.

I, therefore, authorize the release of academic records and personally identifiable information between the high school district I attend and their post-secondary partners for purposes of determining eligibility to enroll in dual credit courses, to create an enrollment record with the post-secondary partner, and support my success in college level coursework. This may include, but is not limited to, application details, academic prerequisite information required to participate in specific courses, attendance records, test scores, progress reports from College instructors, course grades, tuition, and final exam grades.

When applicable, Oregon Tech will release tuition balance & payment information to payers. Oregon Tech will not release academic information to parents or guardians without a FERPA authorization form on file with the institution.

I authorize the release of any information submitted by me in connection with this application to any person, corporation, association or government agency by Oregon Tech only to verify or explain this information.

I represent that the information provided in this application is correct and complete. I understand that this application is only for the Early Owl Program or Dual Credit Program. I acknowledge that if I wish to attend Oregon Tech as a full time student, I must submit a degree seeking application as a first-year student for a future term. I understand if I am found to have made false or misleading statements on this application, or have omitted any required information, I may be subject to discipline, including cancellation of my application or dismissal from the university.
