Articulation Agreement 2018 - 2019 Catalog

It is agreed that students transferring with Clackamas Community College's (Clackamas) Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer (AAOT) program to Oregon Institute of Technology's (Oregon Tech) Bachelor of Science (BS) in Applied Psychology program will be given full credit for all selected courses listed below. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and technical courses at both Clackamas and Oregon Tech, and is subject to a yearly reevaluation by both schools for continuance. This agreement is dated July 1, 2018.

Baccalaureate students must complete a minimum of 60 credits of upper-division work before a degree will be awarded. Upper-division is defined as 300-and 400-level classes at a bachelor's degree granting institution. Baccalaureate students at Oregon Tech must complete 45 credits from Oregon Tech before a degree will be awarded.

Students are responsible for notifying the Oregon Tech Admissions and Registrar's Office when operating under an articulation agreement to ensure their credits transfer as outlined in this agreement. In order to utilize this agreement students must be attending Clackamas Community College during the above catalog year. Students must enroll at Oregon Tech within three years of this approval.
