	 The "home" institution (the college that pays the financial aid) shall be determined by the student's immediate degree objective. For example, if the student's immediate degree objective is a bachelor's degree, then OT will be designated as the home institution. Should the student be pursuing either an Associate of Arts or Science degree prior to completing a bachelor's degree, Clackamas will be designated as the home institution. Once a student has earned an AAS or AAOT, then OT will become the home institution. Students must take at least 6 credits from their home institution to qualify for or receive
