Application	Online application only. Steps for dual enrollm	ent:		
Process	1. Students must be currently admitted at either college.			
	2. Fill out the OT dual application (www.oit.edu/apply).			
	Students can be dually enrolled with multiple colleges at a time, but can only use credits from OT			
	and one dual partner to count toward enrollme	nt for financial aid.		
Re-enrolling	Students who have not attended OT in 4 or more terms must fill out OT's re-enrolling form			
Process	(https://www.oit.edu/admissions/returning-student). Submit transcripts for other colleges			
	attended after leaving OT. Chemeketa Community College transcripts will automatically be sent to			
	OT.			
Deadlines &	Completed applications are due 3 weeks before the term starts. Cost is \$50, payable to OT. No			
App. Fee	cost if student is already admitted to OT.			
Financial	OFAX will be used for transmission of enrollment and grade information.			
Aid	Students cannot have financial aid that pays out from more than one institution.			
	• The "home" institution (the college that pays the financial aid) shall be determined by the			
	student's immediate degree objective. For example, if the student's immediate degree objective			
	is a bachelor's degree, then OT will be designated as the home institution. Should the student			
	be pursuing either an Associate of Arts or Science degree prior to completing a bachelor's			
	degree, Chemeketa will be designated as the home institution. Once a student has earned an			
	AAS or AAOT, then OT will become the home institution.			
	• Students must take at least 6 credits from their home institution to qualify for or receive financial aid.			
Disability	Register with disability services at either institution where accommodations are needed. Each			
Services	institution is responsible for providing accommodations in courses for its campus.			
	Chemeketa DS will process the Dental Hygiene students, and consult with OT on appropriate			
	accommodations. Students must sign a release to OT. Chemeketa will arrange all			
	accommodations and bill OT for accommodations provided in OT classes. Through one			
	process, students will be registered for DS at both schools.
