Re-enrolling	Students who have not attended OT in 4	or more terms must fill out OT's re-enrolling form

Deadlines &	Completed applications are due 3 weeks before the term starts. Cost is \$50, payable to OT. No

Financial	OFAX will be used for transmission of enrollment and grade information.			
Aid	• Students cannot have financial aid that pays out from more than one institution.			
	• The "home" institution (the college that pays the financial aid) shall be determined by the			
	student's immediate degree objective. For example, if the student's immediate degree objective			
	is a bachelor's degree, then OT will be designated as the "home" institution. Should the studen			
	be pursuing Associate degree prior to completing a bachelor's degree, KCC will be designated			
	as the "home" institution. Once a student has earned an Associate degree, then OT will be the home institution. Once a student has earned an AAS or AAOT, then OT will become the			
	home institution.
